

# Project LIVE's Role in Helping Seniors Stay at Home

## How You Can Help



Project LIVE is a program of the Knoxville-Knox County CAC Office on Aging that assists low-income seniors age 60 and older to remain stable in housing or regain stable housing if they are homeless. The program has a partnership with Samaritan Place to assist homeless seniors who live there to find a home of their own. LIVE provides assessment and case management services free of charge to low-income seniors in Knoxville and Knox County. The program also offers volunteer services to assist low-income senior homeowners with minor home repairs, housekeeping, and yard work.

As we have all learned, during difficult economic times, our housing situation may not be as stable as it seems. It can take just a small change in fortune to move us farther from security and closer to the uncertainty of possible homelessness.

Please help LIVE help the seniors it serves to remain secure in their housing. They are always in need of items in the following list. In addition, Project LIVE is always looking for volunteers—individuals, families, and groups—who can help with minor home repair projects, moving, housekeeping, and yard work.


